Movie Content	Covers topic in-depth with details and examples. Subject knowledge is excellent.	Includes essential knowledge about the topic. Subject knowledge appears to be good.	Includes essential information about the topic but there are 1-2 factual errors.	Content is minimal OR there are several factual errors.
Organization and Mechanics of Movie	Content is well organized and follows a clear order. No misspellings or grammatical errors.	Content is well organized and appears to have 1 or 2 minimal errors that do not distract presentation. Three or fewer misspellings and/or mechanical errors.	Content organization has more than 2 errors and impact content organization. Four misspellings and/or grammatical errors.	Content organization is very poor and takes away from presentation. Attractiveness of Movie	Makes excellent use of font, color, graphics, effects, etc. to enhance the presentation.	Makes good use of font, color, graphics, effects, etc. to enhance to presentation. Use of font, color, graphics, effects etc. but these often distract from the presentation content.
Sources	Source information collected for all graphics, facts and quotes. All documented in desired format.	Source information collected for all graphics, facts and quotes. Most documented in desired format.	Source information collected for graphics, facts and quotes, but not documented in desired format.	Very little or no source information was collected.
Requirements	All requirements are met and exceeded.	One requirement was not completely met.	Two requirements were not completely met.	More than two requirements we not completely meet.
